Introduction (audio time: 0:00 – 9:30)

- John the Baptist's disciples' struggle to transition from John to Jesus. John 3:22-26
- An invitation to consider a recent significant change in the listener's life and reflect on how it was managed.

Message Body: How can I foster within myself a heart that is free to embrace change? (audio time: 9:30-22:30)

- John the Baptist himself models to his disciples how they are to embrace this change.
- A. We can embrace change because we can trust God to carry out His will for our lives. Verse 27
 - Our mission is determined by God.
- B. We can embrace change easier when our lives revolve around Jesus. Verse 28
- C. We can embrace change when see the people we in our lives as belonging to Jesus. Verse 29
- D. We can embrace change when we are concerned with making Jesus greater. Verse 30
- E. We can embrace change when we have a revelation of Jesus. Verse 31-35
- F. The Conclusion of the Service. Verse 36 (audio time: 22:30-24:21)
