LOCAL CHURCH



INTERNATIONAL WORKERS

PRAY

Philippians 1:19

A plan for **International Workers** and your church to keep praying for the vision and ministry, and for each other.

FUND

Philippians 4:15

A plan to give to the Global Advance Fund and to consider committing to a portion of the overseas ministry costs that help engage with an unreached people group.

COMMUNICATE

Philippians 1:1

A plan to keep communication consistent in a way that will work best for the International Worker and for your church.

VISIT

Philippians 2:25

- a) The IW's commitment to visiting and reporting to your church on Home Assignment,
- b) A plan, discussed with the International Worker, to consider visiting or working with the IW on-site.

Seamless link Covenant is celebrated commissioning service; the International Worker may be present in person or virtually.

The covenant is a living document that can be changed with the consent of both the IW and the local church. It is set up for a time period of two to four years, depending on the length of the IW's term.

GLOSSARY OF TERMS



- IW: International Worker (Missionary)
- Global Ministries: The C&MA in Canada's international team of people whose purpose is to plant locally led, reproducing churches among least-reached people groups.
- Global Advance Fund: C&MA churches in Canada support their International Workers by pooling their resources to this fund.
