Why it's coming to the Annual General Meeting

As part of its fiduciary duties, the membership of the Christian and Missionary Alliance – Canadian Pacific District is responsible to make decisions regarding the annual audit.

Background

1. During District Conference 2013 a decision was made to allow the District Executive Committee to review and choose a firm to complete the audit that year. After a thorough review, it was determined that a new firm be given the contract for the annual audit work and the firm of Loewen Kruse Chartered Accountants was chosen. This firm is considered a leading expert in charity accounting practices.
2. Since that time, Loewen Kruse Chartered Accountants has made recommendations regarding the way District funds are handled or reported, which have been very helpful to management.
