
Restricted Gifts Policy

The Canadian Pacific District (CPD) may accept donor-restricted gifts (i.e., gifts with conditions attached such as the condition to use the donation only for a building, a scholarship fund, or for a certain ministry project, etc.) only if the gifts:

- a) do not interfere with the direction and control the CPD needs to exercise over its own activities
- b) are consistent with the charitable purposes, mission, and vision of the CPD
- c) do not require the donation to be directed to non-qualified donee (i.e. a donee that is not a Canadian registered charity, which includes individual international workers and any foreign charities)

Gifts that do not meet the above criteria must be returned immediately to the donor.

Restricted gifts accepted by the CPD must be used for the purpose or project as specified by the donor unless that purpose or project has been completed, or for some reason cannot be completed, in which case the Lead Team will have the authority to use the remaining restricted contributions for another charitable activity.

This use of unused restricted gifts must be clearly communicated, preferably in writing, to the donor at the time the gift is received. Without the donor agreeing to this condition at the time the gift is made, the CPD cannot use the remaining funds for a different purpose or project.
